FLORENCE FALLGATTER AND FRANCES MORTON HOLBROOK

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS

The Florence Fallgatter and the Frances Morton Holbrook Awards are granted biennially, in Conclave years, to Phi Upsilon Omicron Alumni to recognize distinguished service and outstanding achievement in family and consumer sciences. Award recipients will receive their expenses paid to attend Conclave, and be recognized with a plaque at Conclave.

ELIGIBILITY is determined by the following criteria:

1. An Alumni member of Phi Upsilon Omicron Honor society (other than Local or National Honorary).
2. A period of ten years since finishing a bachelor's degree.
3. A member who has demonstrated excellence in one of the following areas either through volunteer service or paid employment: business, dietetics/nutrition, education, cooperative extension, journalism, research, social services, volunteer services.
4. A member whose professional expertise and energy have had a significant positive impact on the family and consumer sciences profession.

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE

1. Nominations may be submitted by a College/University or Alumni Chapter, a Phi Upsilon Omicron member, a family and consumer sciences or service organization. A single nomination form is used for both awards. Nomination materials are complete when the following items are submitted to the National Office:
 - * Nomination Form
 - * Vitae, including professional, honorary, civic memberships, affiliations, honors, recognitions, publications
 - * Three letters of recommendation, in sealed envelopes, included with Nomination Form
2. The Selection Committee for reviewing nominations and choosing the recipients shall be composed of:
 - * Chair, Board of Directors, Phi Upsilon Omicron Educational Foundation
 - * Alumni Councilor, National Council, Phi Upsilon Omicron
 - * Alumni member-at-large, Phi Upsilon Omicron; to be selected on a rotating basis by regions by the Region Councilor of the region and the National Alumni Councilor.
